Durham University – Thursday 4 October

To coincide with our topic for this term, Year 5 will be visiting Durham University's Palace Green Library on Thursday 4 October. 'It's all Greek to me!' is an interactive learning day hosted by the university in the Museum of Archaeology. The cost of this visit is £8.50 per pupil to cover admission to the museum and transport costs.

Who were the ancient Greeks? What did they accomplish and what ideas still survive today? These are the very questions that will be answered in this varied and hands-on session.

The bus will leave school at 9.15am and return in time for the end of the school day. Children need to wear their school uniform and will need to bring a packed lunch.
