Expected home learning

Reading for fluency- Children should be encouraged to read at home as often as possible, every night for 5 minutes would be great. We will be using Myon (online reading books) which will launch the first week in October.

Maths - TT Rockstars (online) - Children are expected to complete 15 1-minute games per week.

Optional home learning

Reading for pleasure - Fiction Express (online) - It would be beneficial if children could read a chapter a week. The new chapter on Fiction Express will be released every Friday.

Handwriting - Letterjoin (online) - Children should aim to complete 5-10 minutes as often as possible to help improve their letter formation.
