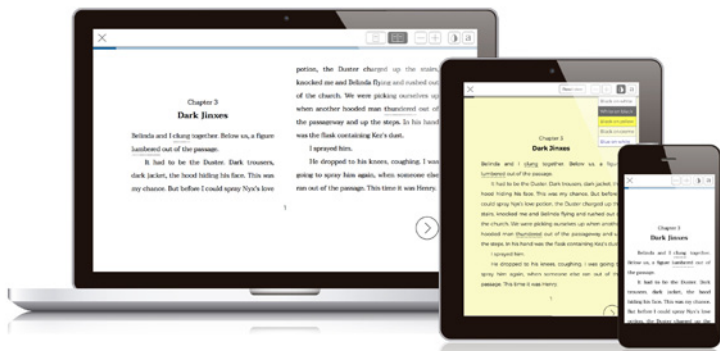

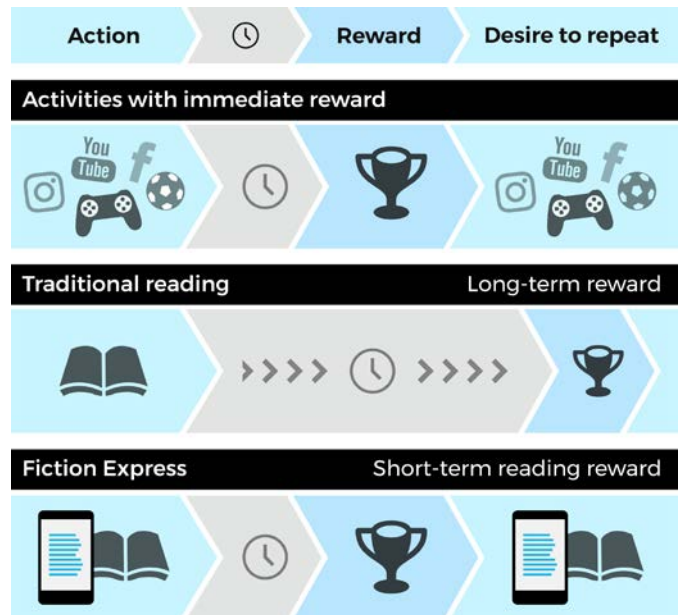

Fiction Express has been designed to improve poor reading habits by getting children excited about reading through the power of engagement and gamification.

Our stories are published weekly. Students read the chapter and at the end, they are rewarded with the option to vote to decide what happens next. The author then writes it in real time. They can also interact on the online book forum with other students worldwide and build the story together.

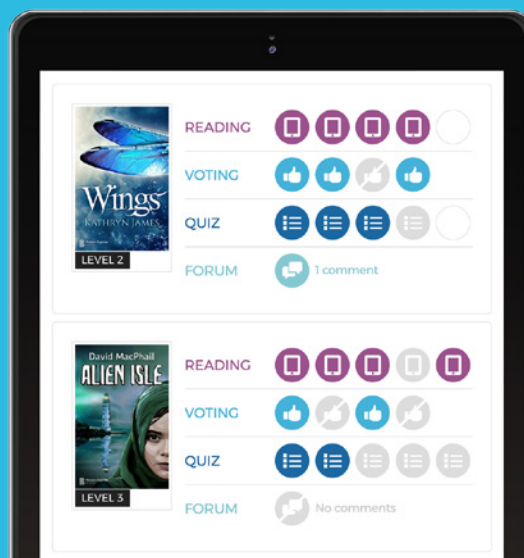
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Student panel

Students take part in creating 18 new books per year. Each student has a personal user panel to access their chosen books, the reading quizzes and the book forums.

Progress review

Students can evaluate their own progress, measure their achievements and are encouraged to read more. They have access to more than 100 Fiction Express books.



Students progress is evidenced in the teacher panel and can be downloaded in PDF format.



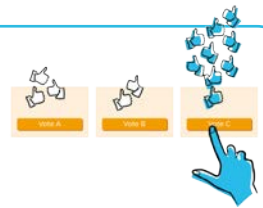
Our 6-step methodology

1 READ the chapter



New chapters of 3 books (different levels) are released weekly. Fiction Express is accessible for dyslexic readers and includes a glossary of 40-80 words per chapter.

2 VOTE on the plot



Readers and authors create together. Thousands of students vote every week to decide what happens next and participate individually or as a whole class.

3 ANSWER the quiz



Each chapter includes an online reading quiz. Students see their results immediately which enhances learning and encourages them to read more.

4 TALK to the author



Through the forum, students have live conversations with the authors and other students worldwide. They can share ideas, opinions and thoughts about the book.

5 ENJOY the activities



Every chapter includes a set of flexible and useful resources that give teachers the option to tie-in Fiction Express into any school focus and scheme of work.

6 MEASURE the impact



Progress is shown on the dashboard highlighting the performance at individual or class level: readings, votes, quiz results and forum interactions.

Resources for class or home

Key areas are highlighted in terms of learning goals and curriculum links, enabling teachers to build Fiction Express into their lesson planning for each term:

- ▶ **READ.** Comprehension questions, guided reading notes and glossary.
- ▶ **WRITE.** Vocabulary, grammar and punctuation worksheets.
- ▶ **TALK.** Discussion points and open discussion activities.
- ▶ **EXPLORE.** Full extension ideas to increase learning potential.
